As we move into the cosy months, here are a few reminders for you all...

Communication (Arbor/Dojo/Office/Instagram/Facebook)

We are always striving to ensure that our communication is as effective and easy as possible as we know how busy and hectic family life can be. All dates below are set for the year, we hope advance notice will enable you to join us where and when possible.

We have communication across a variety of platforms and will endeavour to use them as follows:

- Arbor App – formal emails and letters will be sent via Arbor. It is used for booking and paying for trips, wrap around care and lunches. You can also keep informed of your child's attendance via here too.
- Class Dojo – snippets of class life and specific class messages will be shared via your child's class page. The whole school page will be used for informal reminders and whole school moments.
- Instagram - @Shrewton_CE_Primary is our handle. This is for the highlights – give us a like and share.
- Facebook – parent and F.O.S.S (PTA) pages for informal parent to parent communication.

You can also call the school on 01980 620362 – please be mindful that our office is only staffed until 1pm each day, after that we will try our best to answer your calls and doors but this may take us longer due to working elsewhere in the school.

Home Learning/Reading

Our approach to home learning will continue to be a project linked to a termly theme for you to work on and enjoy together. As ever our biggest focus continues to be on reading. Where possible, please read with your child 3 times per week and record this on BoomReader. Reading books will be sent home as we hear them read through the course of the week. Children should go from sounding out newly learnt sounds to being fully fluent



before a book is changed. They can also have a book to read with you for pleasure.

Lunches

We order lunches on a 3 week rota. Please ensure you complete orders in good time to ensure your child has their lunch ordered for the start of the next cycle.

For pupils with allergies, Apetito have a free app that you can download to check the ingredients. It is called Nutridata.

School Day/Uniform/Absence

Just a reminder that the the school is open to pupils to enter from 8:45am with our register officially closing at 9am by which point all children should be in school with lessons and worship starting at this point. Please be as punctual as possible to ensure pupils have that valuable settling in time.

Please also be mindful of parking at drop off and pick up. No cars should be parked on the yellow markings on the High Street or in front of either of our gates on Tanners Lane.

Uniform: Children should be in black school shoes on uniform days. We will get PE t-shirts and jumpers out as soon as they arrive. Hair should be worn up and no jewellery bar one small earring stud is permitted. Children can continue to wear PE kit on PE days but this should be plain black or blue hoodies (no logo'd hoodies) and Forest School kit on Forest School days. Please make sure ALL uniform and shoes **are named**. Lost property will be kept for a term and then will either be washed and donated to the clothing rail or put in the charity clothing bin. We will aim to display all lost property at the end of every term.

Please report any absence via our absence line or email to enquiries email address. This should be done every day unless we know they will be off for a set period e.g. 48 hours for a sickness bug. This is a full 48 hours from the hour that they were last sick. Just a reminder that no term time holiday will be authorised. Known absence request forms should be completed at least 2 weeks in advance where possible.
